

The Requirement

In Mr. Murphy's own words; "A teacher lecturing in front of the class just isn't as effective as it could be." With that in mind, he has been converting classrooms over to what he has termed 'Model Classrooms'. Each of these rooms have a permanently mounted XGA projector, a large 60 x 80 screen, a new computer dedicated to the projector, a hi-fi sound system, a VCR and DVD player, and the most used item, a Visualizer.
